**Objectives-**

- The primary objective of this committee is to ensure that ragging of students admitted to Shri Dhanwantry Ayurvedic College and hospital is totally prohibited.
- It also includes to prohibit any act which causes, or is likely to cause any physical, psychological or physiological harm of shame or embarrassment to a student.
- Anti-ragging committee of SDACH aims to ensure a ragging free campus. The committee tries to develop a friendly atmosphere between senior and junior students in the college.
- The committee objective is to fulfil organizational missions and objectives, by maintaining free of ragging, prohibit, prevent and eliminate the menace of ragging.

**Functions and Responsibilities-**

- The core function of the committee is to take all the necessary measures to make campus environment jovial and ragging free.
- The committee has to monitor the displaying of charts and other material like flexes, posters and boards stating evil nature, punishment of ragging and also student's discipline.
- The committee has to arrange counselling and guidance programmes for the fresher's and parents regarding ragging.
- The committee has to provide the information pertaining to contact address and telephone numbers of the person(s) identified to receive complaints.
- The committee has to take affidavits from the students and parents regarding ragging during the admission.
- The committee has to inform the prevalent directives and the actions that can be taken against those indulging in ragging.
- The Committee will also maintain alert vigil at all times and ensure that the Anti-Ragging Squads/Anti- Ragging Helpline of the college carry out their functions properly and efficiently.
- The committee shall take appropriate action in case an incident of ragging is reported by Anti-Ragging Squad of the institute.

### **ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD(Flying Squad Committee)**
