The following resolution is arrived at the end of the meeting.

- The college council members have been appraised 2021-22 admission. Out of 100 seats, 63 seats filled up through first & second round by Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra, Haryana. Remaining 37 seats will be filled after conversion of SC seats and NRI seats to general category in 11.04.2022. Also appraised about P.G. Admission.
- 2.
