REPORT OF COLLEGE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 10TH MARCH, 2021

The College Council members have expressed their happiness and extended their heartfelt gratitude for getting additional 40 seats in BAMS course.

It was sincerely recognized and appreciated the contribution and co-operation of all the staff members in achieving the major mile stone. The college council thanked the management for their continuous support in Upgradation of the infrastructure that is required for 100 seats.

The following resolution is arrived at the end of the meeting.

1. The college council members have been appraised 2020-21 admission. Out of 60 seats, 57 seats are filled up through first mop-up round 26th and 27th Feb, 2021 by Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra, Haryana. Three students have not joined. The information has passed to the University authorities. In the second mop-up round the list of 43 candidates, sent by Shri Krishna AYUSH University have to join on 11th and 12th March, 2021.
2. After having the discussion with all members, it is decided to start first BAMS course w.e.f. 19.03.2021 taking into consideration, auspicious date and giving some time for parents to prepare and leave their wards into the institution the college council members have been appraised with transitional curriculum and its time table circulated by CCIM. After deliberate discussion members have suggested their views and the list of eminent ASU persons who are to be invited. Keeping the Covid-19 situation in view, the members have decided that all the Guest lecturer will be through zoom meeting. The entire program for transitional curriculum has been finalized.
3. After thorough discussion the council members felt that in order to improve their knowledge in Ayurvedic fundamentals and to strengthen Samhita knowledge, decided to implement Astang Hridya. Samhita Paranayam daily for first BAMS. The practice which is in vogue in several parts of the country. In order to implement this program and to find out space after deliberate discussion, 5 minutes time has taken from each hour. Morning 08:30 AM to 09:00 AM half an hour has been fixed for Samhita Pranayama, accordingly alteration in the time table has been made and accepted.
4. In order to enforce discipline and for effective rapport among students, teachers, and parents the council has decided to implement Mentor, mentis for first BAMS students accordingly Dr.R. Vidyanath, Professor and HoD, Samhita has been appointed as class Mentor for first year & student have been divided equally to the teachers of first BAMS concerned.
