DICIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Objectives

- The main objective of the committee is to maintain discipline in the campus, college premises, classroom as well as in the hospitals wherever the students are posted.
- To achieve the goal of creating a safe environment by supporting the use of positive attitudes and practices.
- To uptake measures for inappropriate behaviour including progressive discipline comprising suspension and expulsion where necessary.

Functions and Responsibilities

- The core function of the College Discipline Committee is to create a safe and motivating environment in our institution and to bring professionalism among students by the inculcation of best practices.
- The committee has to ensure all the students should wear their ID Cards while they are in the campus and their respective class rooms.
- In case of any violation of dress code or disturbance in the class, the ID card will be confiscated from the student which will be handed over to the student on the same day with a warning and advice from the Disciplinary Committee Members.
- In case of any misbehaviour or violation of the college rules, the ID cards of the students will be kept with the Disciplinary Committee Members till the enquiry is over.
- The committee has to enforce total prohibition of cell phone usage by the students in the classroom during lectures.
- The committee has to monitor the movement of the students in the college and prevent students loitering around in the corridors during the college working hours.
- The committee has to ensure that all the students attend classes without bunking and prevent them from leaving the college early.
- The committee has to ensure that no student can leave the college early without prior permission from the concerned authorities.
- The committee has to ensure that smoking is strictly prohibited in the college campus and ensures that this is being strictly followed.

- The committee has to ensure that students maintain complete silence in the library.
- The committee has to maintain proper discipline in the college canteen and student waiting room during the college working hours.
- If any damage is caused to the college property by any student / group of students, the cost of the same will be recovered with a fine from the said student / group of this will be followed by disciplinary action.
- If any indiscipline is found by any of the students, the committee has to warn them on the first instance, have to take disciplinary action based on the rules and regulations of the committee, if the pattern of misconduct continues.
- The committee has to assist the college anti-ragging committee in preventing ragging in the College and to spread anti-ragging campaign throughout the students community.
