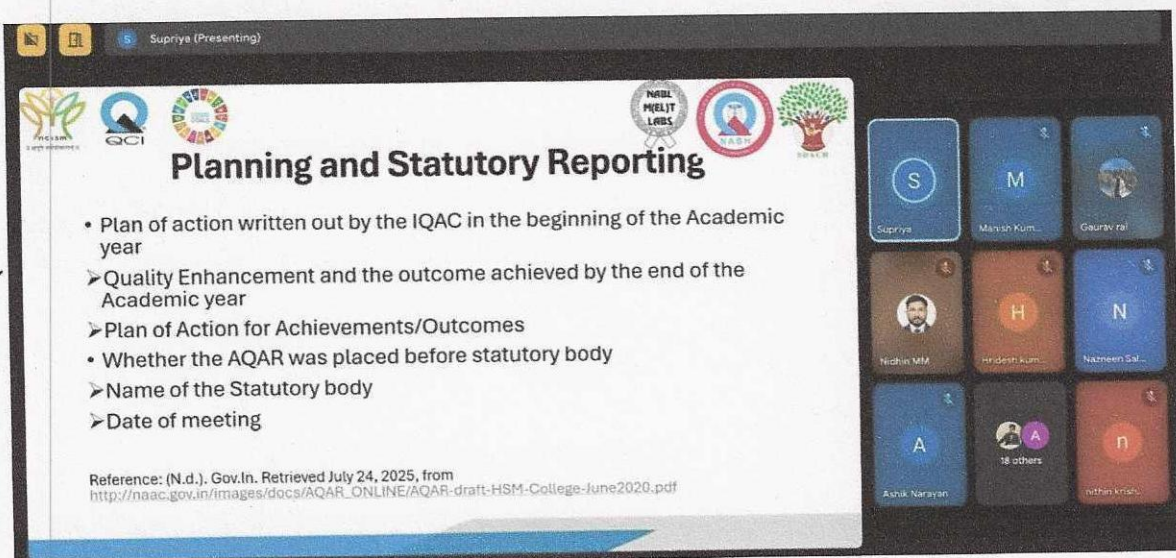
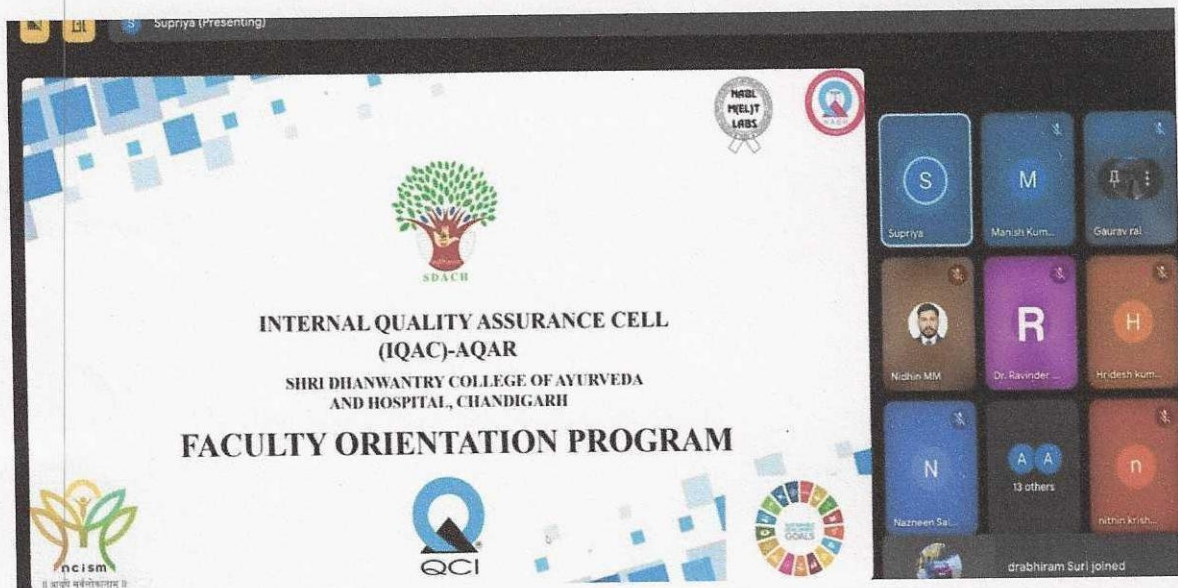
### 3. Brief Report (Summary of the Event)

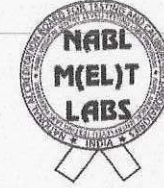

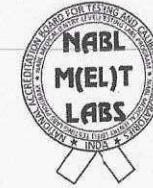

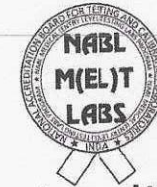

The composition of the IQAC may be as follows:

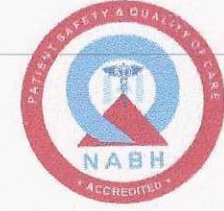
1. Chairperson: Head of the Institution

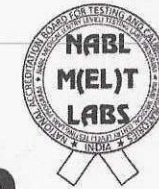




It is necessary for the members of the IQAC to shoulder the responsibilities of generating and promoting awareness in the institution. A few of them are listed below:

- It is advisable to choose persons from various backgrounds who have earned respect for integrity and excellence in their teaching and research. Moreover, they should be aware of the ground realities of the institutional environment. They should be known for their commitment to improving the quality of teaching and learning.
- It is advisable to change the co-ordinator after two to three years to bring new thoughts and activities in the institution.
- It would be appropriate to choose as senior administrators, persons in charge of institutional services such as library, computer center, estate, student welfare, administration, academic tasks, examination and planning and development.
- The management representative should be a person who is aware of the institution's objectives, limitations and strengths and is committed to its improvement. The local society representatives should be of high social standing and should have made significant contributions to society and in particular to education.

- In order to do this, the IQAC will have to first establish procedures and modalities to collect data and information on various aspects of institutional functioning.

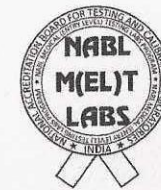
- IQAC may derive major support from the already existing units and mechanisms that contribute to the functions listed above.
- The Institutions are requested to submit the AQAR after one year from date of Accreditation every year. A functional IQAC and timely submission of AQARs are the Minimum Institutional Requirements (MIR) to volunteer for second, third or subsequent cycle's accreditation.
- The AQAR shall be approved by the statutory bodies of the HEIs (such as Syndicate, Governing Council/Executive Council/Board of Management) for the follow up action for necessary quality enhancement measures.
- The IQACs may create its exclusive window tab on its institutional website for keeping the records/files of NAAC/QCI, Peer Team Reports, AQAR, and Certificate of Accreditation Outcomes and regularly upload reports on its activities, as well as for hosting the AQAR.

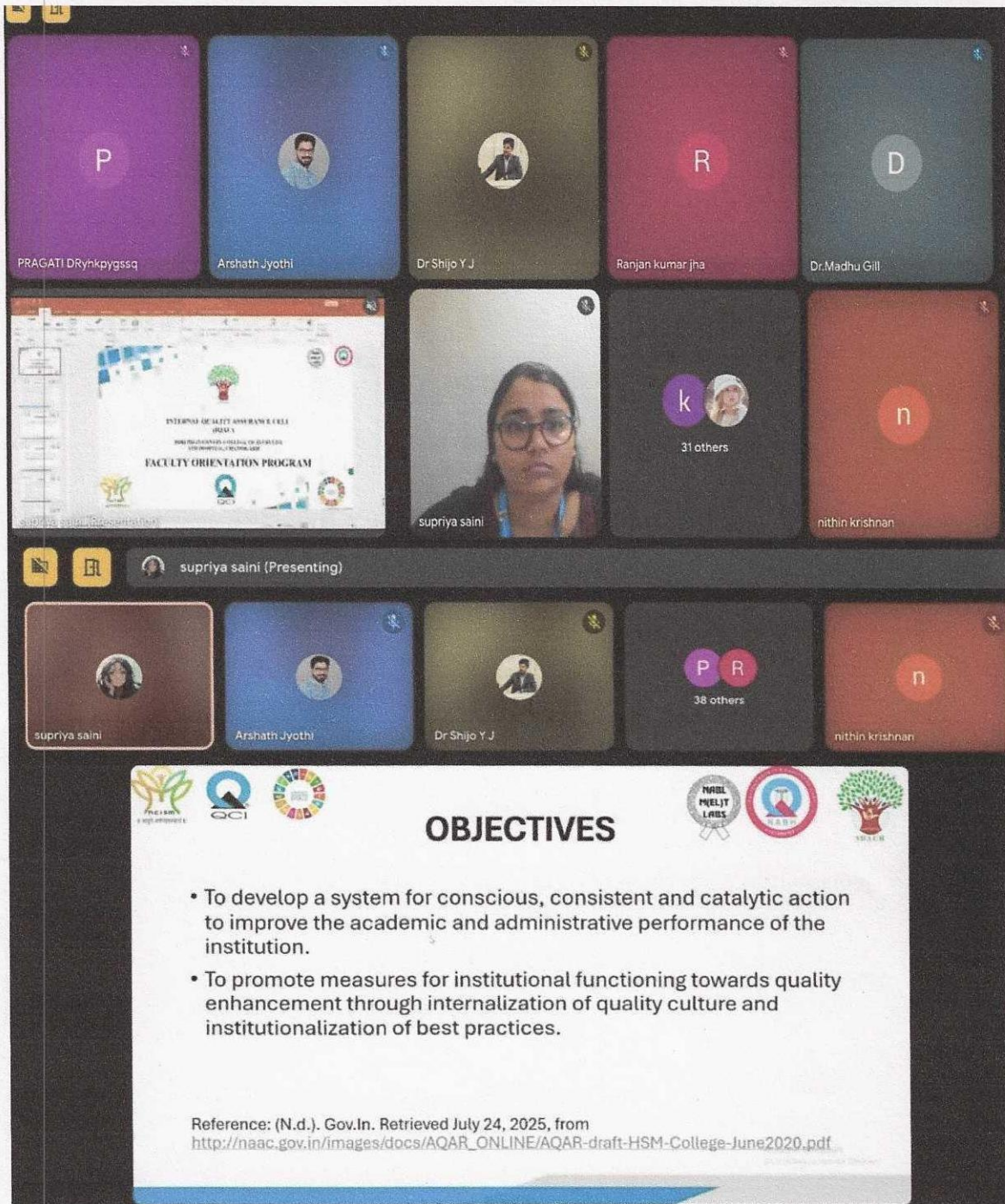
### 3. Brief Report (Summary of the Event)
