

Discussion and Resolutions:

1. Discussion on Unique Selling Policies (USP) of the Institution

Discussion:

3. Postgraduate Department Strengthening

Discussion:

- The need to improve postgraduate education quality was discussed. Suggestions
 included offering skill-based training, fostering research initiatives, and increasing
 collaborations with external institutions.
- Challenges related to infrastructure and faculty workload were also highlighted.

Resolution:

 A committee comprised by Heads of PG Departments will assess current gaps and propose a detailed roadmap for PG department strengthening by 20th October 2024.

4. Framing of UG/PG Admission Committees and Defining Roles and Responsibilities

Discussion:

- The council discussed the necessity of clearly defined admission committees for UG and PG programs to ensure a smooth and transparent admission process.
- Roles such as screening applications, organizing entrance tests, and conducting interviews were outlined.

Resolution:

- UG Admission Committee framing
- PG Admission Committee framing
- Detailed guidelines and responsibilities will be circulated by Admission Coordinator by 10th September 2024.

5. Postgraduate Academic Curriculum

Discussion:

- The need to orient PG Academic curriculum to Post Graduate departments is planned.
- As per the new PG curriculum the faculties need to be oriented regarding the same for effective delivery and design a dynamic timetable for planning and execution.

Resolution:

- A committee comprised by Academic committee coordinator will plan for orientation programs for the faculties by 20th October 2024.

7. Winter Vacation Schedule

Discussion:

The proposed winter vacation schedule for faculty, staff, and students was discussed.
 Care was taken to ensure that the vacation period did not disrupt hospital or academic activities.

Resolution:

The final winter vacation schedule was approved – First half (24th December 2024 to 09th January 2025) and Second half (11th January 2025 to 27th January 2025)

• Department heads were instructed to ensure proper duty rotation during this period.
