- The committee has to ensure effective solution to the one's grievances, resolved on time impartially and confidentially.
- The committee has to prepare statistical reports about the number of cases received.
- All grievances referred to the Grievance Redressal committee /Principal/ Director shall be entered in a register to be maintained .The number of grievances, settled or pending will be reported to the Principal every 15days.
- The Chairman of the committee has to report to the authority (management) about the cases attended to and the number of pending cases, if any, which require direction and guidance from the higher authorities.
