### REPORT OF COLLEGE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 14.12.2022

The College Council members have expressed their happiness and extended their heartfelt gratitude for getting permission in MD Rog Nidan 6 seats & MS Prasuti Tantra evum Stri Roga 6 seats.

It was sincerely recognized and appreciated the contribution and co-operation of all the staff members in achieving the major mile stone. The college council thanked the management for their continuous support in Upgradation of the infrastructure that is required for BAMS UG 100 seats & PG 24 seats (04 Subjects 6 seats in each).

The following resolution is arrived at the end of the meeting.

- The college council members have been appraised 2022-23 admission. Out of 100 UG seats, 96 seats are filled up through first mop-up round 13.02.2023 by Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra, Haryana. Four students have not joined. The information has passed to the University authorities.
- 2.   - In order to implement this program and to find out space after deliberate discussion. Morning 08:45 AM to 09:00 AM half an hour has been fixed for Samhita Pranayama, accordingly alteration in the time table has been made and accepted.
- 4. In order to enforce discipline and for effective rapport among students, teachers, and parents the council has decided to implement Mentor, mentis for first BAMS students accordingly Dr. Ranjan Kumar Jha, Associate Professor, Sharir Rachana has been appointed as class Mentor for first year & Mr. Abhishek Kaushal, Assistant Professor, Basic Principles has been appointed as class Sub-Mentor for first year & student have been divided equally to the teachers of first BAMS concerned.
