Feedback Collection

Implement methods to gather feedback from participants post-event for evaluation.



Photographic Evidence

Capture images of activities and key moments throughout the event for documentation.



Follow-up Actions

Outline steps that need to be taken after the event to maintain engagement.



Final Report

Compile a comprehensive report summarizing the event's success and areas for improvement.

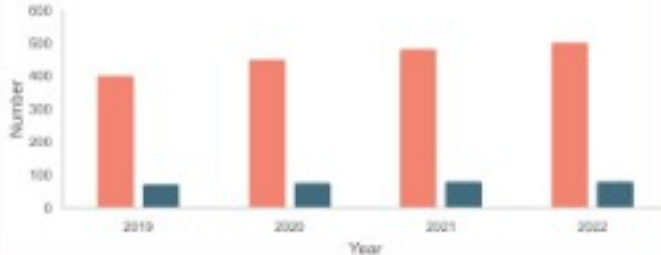

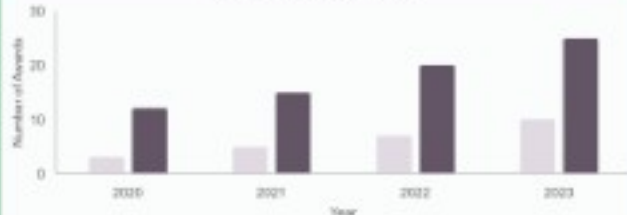

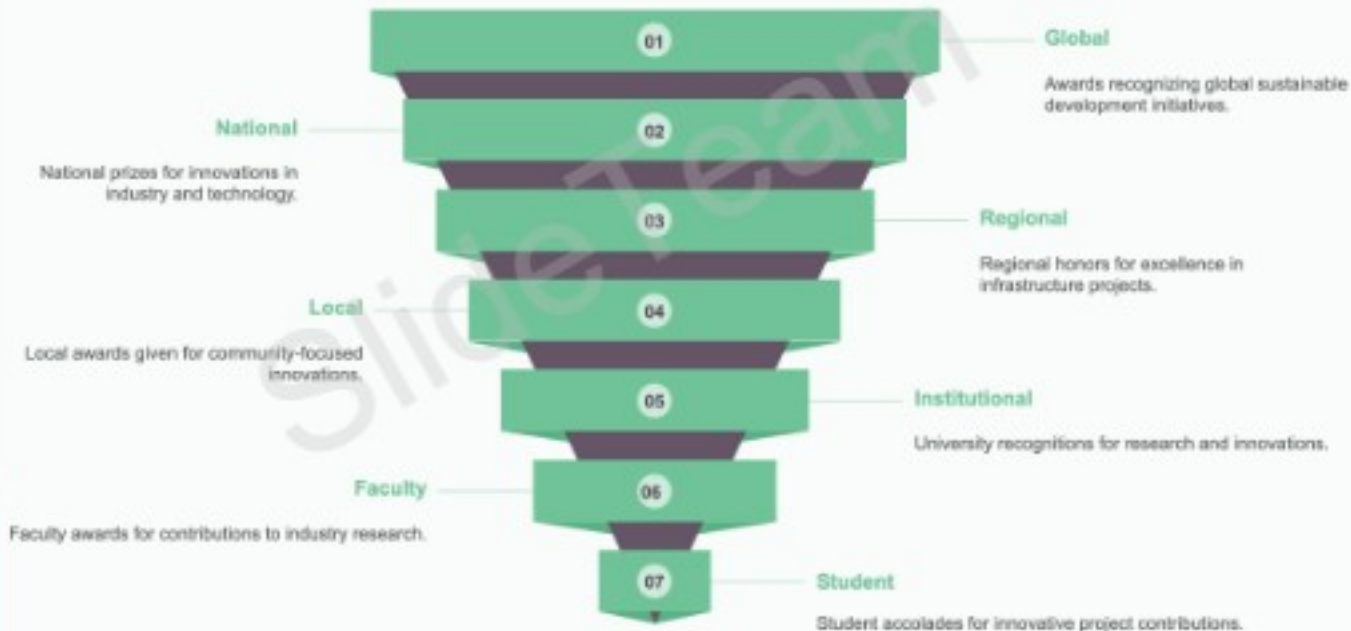

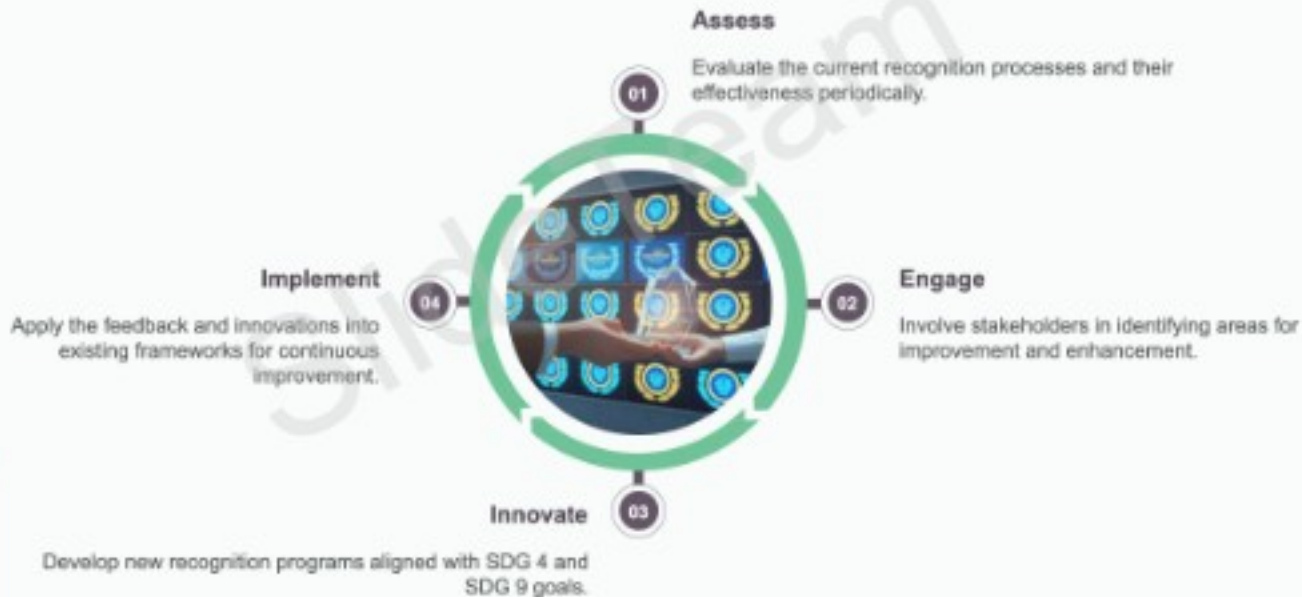


Impact of Awards on Motivation and Performance

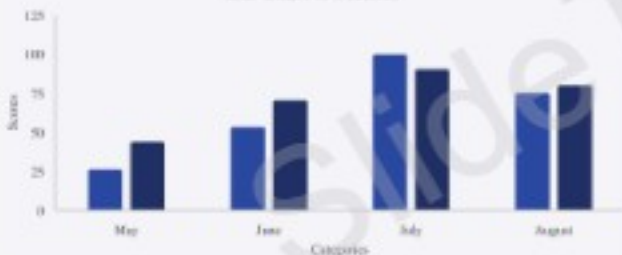
