1. Purpose

The Anti-Ragging Squad is responsible for **active monitoring and prevention of ragging activities on campus and in hostels.**

2. Constitution

The Anti Ragging (Flying Squad) Squad is appointed by the **General Secretary** of the institute.

3. Responsibilities

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall:

1. Conduct **regular patrols** in hostels, classrooms, and campus.
2. Monitor **areas prone to ragging.**
3. Interact with junior students.
4. Maintain communication with Faculty Mentors to identify high-risk students or sensitive cases.
5. Immediately intervene in suspected ragging cases.
6. Report incidents to the **Anti-Ragging Committee.**

4. Monitoring Areas

The squad monitors:

- Main building and academic block
- Hostel premises
- Sports Ground
- Parking area
- Canteen areas
- Library
- Campus corridors
- Hospital OPD/IPD areas

5. Surprise Inspections

The squad conducts **random inspections**, particularly during:

6. Reporting System

If ragging is suspected:

1. Immediate intervention is made.
2. Incident reported to **Anti-Ragging Committee**.
3. The Faculty Mentor of the affected student is informed for immediate emotional support.
4. Written report submitted to the **Principal**.

7. Documentation

The squad maintains:

- Patrol register/ Inspection register
- Incident report file

8. Coordination

The Anti-Ragging Squad works under the supervision of the **Anti-Ragging Committee** and collaborates with Faculty Mentors for grass-root level information.
